THE WEST KENT CUBS CHAMPIONSHIP
Championship Rules

1. Eligibility

Senior Cubs must be under 13 years of age at 00.00hrs on 1st January 2010 and be in possession of a certified handicap.

Junior Cubs must be under 10 years of age at 00.00hrs on 1st January 2010.

Entrants must be members of a club affiliated to the Kent County Golf Union or Kent County Ladies Golf Association.

Entries will be limited to the number permitted by the host Club and, if necessary, may be restricted by ballot.

2. Caddies

Senior Cubs will not be allowed caddies or trolley pullers.

Junior Cubs will be allowed one caddie only.

3. The Competition

The Competition will be Medal Play over 18 holes for both Senior and Junior Cubs.

4. Championship Results

The Senior and Junior Cubs Champions will be the players who return the lowest gross score. In the event of a tie the Championships will be decided by a "sudden death" play off.

5. Age Group Prizes

Prizes will be awarded in each age group based on gross and nett scores. Prizes for nett scores will only be awarded to players who have provided proof of a certified handicap. In the event of a tie the winner will be decided by count-back. No competitor may win more than one prize.

6. Practice Rounds

Competitors should make their own arrangements with the Secretary of the host club and may be required to pay a green fee.

7. Rules

Play will be under the Rules of the R&A in conjunction with the local rules of the Host Club. Disputes shall be referred to the Championship Committee immediately after completion of the round and their decision shall be final. All entries shall be subject to the approval of the Championship Committee, which reserve the right to accept or refuse any entry without giving any reasons for their decision, which shall be final.

8. Distance Measuring Devices (DMD's)

Distance measuring devices are permitted but only those that calculate distance. Those providing other information such as wind speed, temperature and elevation, will not be allowed. Any player found using such a DMD will be in breach of Rule 14-3 for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

9. Ride on buggies. Except in cases when Competitors claim exemption under the provisions of the Disability Discrimination Acts 1995 and 2005 upon the production of a Medical Certificate signed by a Registered Medical Practitioner, all other Competitors shall be prohibited from riding on motorised buggy carts, except with the explicit permission of the Championship Committee. Penalty for Breach of Condition is Disqualification. Medical Certificates must be provided to the Secretary no less than 5 clear days prior to the start of any competition administered by the Union. Competitors shall always be responsible for providing their buggy.

Competitors must conform in all respects with the dress rules of the host club both on and off the course.
